THE MKE BIPOC EDUCATOR ADVISORY GROUP

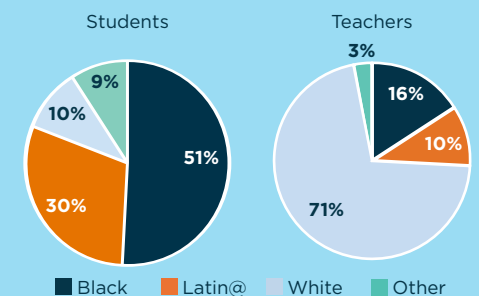

FEW TEACHERS OF COLOR IN MILWAUKEE CLASSROOMS:

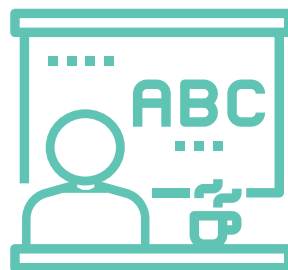
